### **Student Eligibility**

High school seniors studying piano with a teacher who is a member of TMTA (Texas Music Teachers Association) for two or more years, including the full senior year, and who will enter college as a music major, are eligible candidates for this award. All candidates must meet the requirements listed below.

### **Teacher Eligibility**

The teacher of the candidate for this award must have held TMTA membership for the past two years or provide other acceptable credentials and be approved by the CAMF board

### **Requirements**

The candidate must have high musical capability in knowledge and performance.

The candidate must hold membership in Student Affiliate of TMTA.

The candidate must have taken and passed the appropriate theory exam as set forth by TMTA guidelines. The student must take the TMTA theory test to apply for the scholarship.

### **Performance Requirements**

The candidate must have performed in at least two adjudicated events in the last 12 months. The two adjudicated events must be completed by the deadline for the scholarship. Any additional performances or competitions engaged in by the candidate are optional and may be included in the application.

### **Audition Requirements**

Applicant is required to perform two pieces and be interviewed by the board members of the Carter Albrecht Music Foundation.

Applicant must provide for the foundation two recommendations other than the private teacher. Location of the audition will be at 5620 Hillsborough Drive, Plano, TX 75093 or a location to be determined.

### **Application and Deadline for Entry**

The application form is available upon request at [judyalbrecht@verizon.net](mailto:judyalbrecht@verizon.net) or [www.carteralbrechtmusicfoundation.org](http://www.carteralbrechtmusicfoundation.org). The candidate will submit this application as well as the following:

1. Copy of theory test results
2. Copies of two adjudicated event results
3. Letter from the teacher verifying student's length of study and teacher's credentials.
4. Two letters of recommendation other than the recommendation of the teacher.
5. A digital picture of the applicant.

The actual deadline is anytime after the student has proof of college acceptance as a music major but no later than June 30.

### **Selection of Recipients**

The CAMF committee will inform the applicant of the interview/audition results.

### **Monetary Amount**

The amounts will vary from year to year. Each recipient will receive up to \$2,000. The amount will be determined by the CAMF board. Checks will be paid to the student only after verification of college acceptance as a music major.
