Student Eligibility

High school senior who has studied at least two years with current teacher and has been accepted into college as a music major.

All applicants must meet the following requirements

Teacher Eligibility

The teacher of the applicant for this award must have held TMTA membership for the past two years or other credentials approved by the CAMF board.

Requirements

The applicant must have taken and passed level 8 or higher of the TMTA Theory Exam

OR

The applicant must have studied and received a passing grade in a High School Music Theory class.

The CAMF board will consider similar programs as well.

Performance Requirements

The candidate must provide a copy of adjudicated comment sheets from a recent festival or performance. Any additional performances or competitions engaged in by the applicant are optional and may be included in the application.

Audition and Interview Requirements

Applicant is required to provide a video performance. An interview with the CAMF board members will be arranged. When public health and safety guidelines permit, the audition and interview will take place in-person at a designated time and place in Texas.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Applicant must provide two recommendation letters in addition to the teacher recommendation.

Application and Deadline for Entry

The actual deadline is any time after the student has proof of college acceptance as a music major but **no later than June 15**.
